

Murdoch Drive Connection to Roe Highway and Kwinana Freeway

Roadworks update

Upcoming closures and night works on Farrington Road

The Murdoch Drive Connection project comprises the extension of Murdoch Drive south from Farrington Road to provide connections to Roe Highway and Kwinana Freeway. As part of these works, the roundabout at Murdoch Drive and Farrington Road will be upgraded to incorporate traffic signals which will allow the roundabout to function efficiently in peak hour situations, or when emergency vehicles need priority access.

Farrington Road eastbound will be closed to traffic along with lane closures westbound to enable the installation of signal loops and road signs, and to safely do brick paving and landscaping in roadside medians.

Closure and night works: Farrington Road eastbound between Bibra Drive and Murdoch Drive

- **Saturday 26 October, 6am to 10pm***
- Eastbound closed to traffic
- Detours via Bibra Drive, Hope Road, Progress Drive, Gwilliam Drive, North Lake Road, South Street and Murdoch Drive, as shown on the right

Lane closure and night works: Farrington Road westbound between Bibra Drive and Murdoch Drive

- **Saturday 26 October, 6am to 10pm***
- Westbound right lane closures


These works and vehicle movements throughout the area may be noticeable to nearby residents, however every effort will be made to reduce construction noise and vibration where possible.

To minimise disturbance to residents as much as possible, an out-of-hours noise management plan has been prepared by the Metropolitan Road Improvement Alliance and approved by your Local Government Authority. Please proceed with caution, and adhere to the 40km/h speed limit which is signposted for the duration of construction in the area.

**Please note that these are projected timeframes and are subject to change due to weather and/or other factors. Regular updates will be posted on the Main Roads website and emailed to those subscribed to project updates. Where applicable, Variable Message Sign Boards on site will provide up-to-date information. Please plan ahead and allow extra travel time as delays may occur.*
