

HOW DO I APPLY?

Details on how to apply for the Australian Government ICT Cadetship Program are available on our website at www.australia.gov.au/ictentrylevel

To apply you must:

- be an Australian Citizen, or going to be granted Australian Citizenship before you commence employment and be able to provide evidence of this
- have completed the first year (full-time equivalent) of your undergraduate degree in ICT, or your undergraduate degree with an ICT major
- be able to complete your University studies in a minimum of 18 months and a maximum of 3 years
- \bullet be able to pass a security assessment



ICT: START HERE GO ANYWHERE

If you are looking for a challenge, are able to work as part of a team and have a keen interest in ICT, then kick start your career with the Australian Government ICT Cadetship Program!

As an ICT Cadet you will experience:

- a competitive starting salary
- a stable, part-time permanent job
- flexible working arrangements
- a generous study allowance
- training opportunities
- support from managers and colleagues

WHAT WILL I DO?

You will be employed at the APS2 level (or equivalent) in one of the many exciting Australian Government Agencies participating in the Program, across the country. You will work a minimum two days per week as part of a team in one of the following ICT related areas:

- infrastructure support
- networking
- programming
- applications development
- web development
- systems testing
- systems analysis and design
- systems management

The remainder of your working week will be dedicated towards your University study, which should take you a minimum of 18 months and a maximum of 3 years to finish. Your ICT Cadetship will be complete when you successfully graduate from University.



During your Cadetship you will also receive a generous study allowance to support your University costs.

HOW WILL I STAY ON TRACK?

To help you succeed in your ICT Cadetship, you will be provided with a large amount of support.

Your workplace supervisor will guide you in your day-to-day work, answer questions and provide you with advice. A dedicated Career Development and Support Officer will also assist with your academic and workplace progress, as well as act as an informal mentor and career coach.

You will also have the opportunity to participate in networking events where you can socialise with other ICT Cadets in order to develop professional and social networks.

In addition, you will participate in training activities which will provide you with the skills and knowledge you need to become a high performing Australian Government employee.

WILL I KEEP MY JOB AFTER THE PROGRAM?

Yes! You will be employed as a permanent Australian Government employee from day one. During your ICT Cadetship you will also be provided with training on interview skills and application writing to help you increase your opportunities for promotion in the Australian Government at the end of the Program.
