In the dawn of time...

- Event was run last year
 - Handover
 - We have the wrapup meeting from last year.
 - Who has RSA / First Aid?
 - Caira: RSA + First Aid + Food Safety
 - Alaura: First Aid + Food Safety
 - Aoibhinn: RSA + First Aid + Food Safety
 - Felix: Food Safety
 - Ed: No qualifications
 - Don't turn the lights on where they should be turned off.
 - Need decorations
 - Aoibhinn: currently looking into decorations
 - Need a floor plan
 - Required to give to Events for Liquor License
 - Minutes
 - Last year was bad for minutes
 - Lots of excitement and not so much beaurocracy
 - Event was held in the CCZ
 - Alcohol
 - 2 security guards
 - Decorations
 - CCZ is too large, need to restrict the space a little
 - Last year, lots of people ended up playing Werewolf in a small room in a corner

- Need to stop that from happening again.
- CCZ can be rented for free
- Pizza shouldn't have been free
 - Pizza was not of good quality
 - Bought too much pizza
 - Too many vegetarians
- Clubs should decide which drinks to buy
 - Some more expensive soft drinks were purchased, nobody wanted to reimburse it.
 - Alaura: Can buy the drinks since I've done lots of Unigames drinks run.
- Idea of event was a party with multiple rooms with different themes
 - Baggage area was a thing, can exist again this year if only used to drop bags.
 - Each room was handled by a different person
- Turnout: somewhere in the realm of 40, 23 tickets online, physical tickets not labelled.
- Issues with finance, "was real complicated"
- Paid for a photographer
 - Cair: Friends in photography club
 - *Alaura shows subcommittee the 40 photos from the event*
 - Photos from last year can be used as advertising for this year.
- Ed: Much positive feedback received from attendees last year, despite trainwreck behind the scenes.
- Do we want to run the event this year?
 - Possible types of events:
 - Party
 - Easy to run, people can dress up
 - Haunted house
 - Subcommittee agrees
 - TODO: Ed will set up a private Facebook page for the event organisation.
- Subcommittee regulations
 - Subcommittee attempts to locate the new subcommittee regulations
 - Subcommittee has apparently already located the new subcommittee regulations.

But what are we going to do now?!

- 20-30 people
 - In leadup to the event, if we sell more tickets, we can adjust space allocation of CCZ
- Cameron Hall friend group (Facebook) wants Karaoke!
- Ticketing options:
 - **Ticket price is \$20**
 - Early bird purchases:
 - Free drink voucher for 1 alcoholic / non-alcoholic beverage
 - Early bird ends 2 weeks before event (Friday 2018-10-12 23:59 AWST)
 - Online ticketing:

- Surcharges apply
 - Trybooking was used last year, does coupon based stuff, time-sensitive discounts, etc.
 - TODO: Alaura to look into online ticketing
- Early bird price
 - Incentivises bringing people's friends
- Membership discount
 - Ed: People don't really think about it as a discount, just the "normal"
- Drink vouchers:
 - Mocktails: people can add a shot of alcohol if they want
 - Instead of a discount, you can get a drink voucher with the ticket if you buy it early.
 - Unigames Camp used similar scheme of "snack vouchers"
 - Alaura: Camp is quite a different scenario to this event, vouchers were more related to not having cash
 - Alaura: Good incentive to buy a ticket, ultimately a good way to make more money
- Ed: We should run a hype event to boost attendance and make people excited.
 - Halloween boardgames night (Unigames)
 - Horror film screenings (UCC/UniSFA collaboratively)
 - Costumes workshop
 - Horror oneshot RPG (Unigames)
 - Halloween LANs (UCC)
- **Material requirements for this event**
 - Decorations
 - CCZ has a number of rooms:
 - 2 meeting rooms
 - Craft space with big sliding doors
 - Large open space with partitioned desks
 - Large open space with tables
 - U-shaped bench space
 - Some booths with tables
 - Audiovisual room
 - Alaura did the "Meme Room" in here last year
 - Was a bunch of halloween meme videos
 - Balcony
 - Alcohol (hopefully can purchase via the Tavern)
 - 2 beer options
 - Cider option
 - Wine option
 - Cocktail / mocktail options
 - Pricing will be based on sale price from Tavern
 - TODO: Alaura - Contact Tavern about alcoholic beverage sale prices.
 - Non-alcoholic beverages
 - Mocktails
 - Themes?
 - Mocktails can be turned into cocktails by adding shots of liquors.
 - Canned soft drinks
 - Alaura: If we buy cans under Unigames' cost, Unigames may be able to buy back excess.
 - Printing for posters & tickets
 - Security guard(s)
 - Food
 - Lollies, chocolates, snacks, etc.

- Dinner: pizza is provided (?)
 - Ticket price goes up
 - Ed: People see higher ticket price, don't think about context, less likely to come
- Dinner: Pizza run
 - Pizza run is less hassle in terms of overcatering / dietary Requirements
 - Quick hands up shows that 1 subcommittee member has license, one more will have license at time of event
 - Pizza voucher where people can specify dietary requirements
- Pastries platter (?)

Who is coming?

- Clubs involved:
 - UCC
 - Unigames
 - UniSFA
 - Not UWAnime
 - Pantomime Society, but miscommunication resulted in their reps missing the first meeting.
- Open to non-members, no member-specific discounts / benefits

When are we going to run it?

- Halloween is the Wednesday 31st October
- Possible dates are Saturday 27/10/2018 or Wednesday 31/10/2018
- The Tavern should be open, we can order food on the night if necessary
 - It *might* be feasible to give food orders to the Tav on the night if we ask people what they want at the door
 - Probably we can give them approximate numbers in advance and give exact numbers on the day
 - TODO: Felix to contact the Tav and ask about catering
