

OKAY! I'VE SIGNED UP! NOW WHAT?

Find us! There is a map with our clubroom location (Cameron Hall) on the inside cover of this guide, there are also some useful signs to help direct you when you get a bit closer. Once you're there, meet some of our members! The spotter's guide at the back of the booklet can (but probably won't) help you identify some of them! Also have a wander around Cameron Hall; there are a few other cool clubs around.

CAMERON HALL CLUBS

University Computer Club (UCC) - One of the oldest clubs in Cameron Hall, UCC is located just across from UniSFA. Joining UCC will grant you access to their Wi-Fi network (which we conveniently have a router for in the clubroom), allow you to purchase their soft drinks & snacks, enable you to use their computers and possibly (if you ask nicely) cause them to have patience if you encounter technical problems. They also have music, video games and a coffee table.

Unigames - Games as in the table top type, not the outdoors type; people have made that mistake before. Unigames is located in the main hallway of Cameron Hall, and has an extensive range of sourcebooks as well as board games. We have quite a large crossover of members with Unigames and as such, there are joint events (see Events). Join Unigames if you're interested in any sort of tabletop, card or board games! They also have a large range of foodstuffs available for purchase.

UWAnime - Admittedly, we have the least crossover of members with UWAnime but they do have a great range of anime and manga, and hold occasional screenings. You can find this club hidden down the passageway next to Unigames.

WHY SHOULD YOU STAY, YOU ASK?

Because UniSFA is a social club with great members and you make friends that you will probably have for the rest of your life. We also have a few benefits specific to the club besides the nerds

CLUBROOM

Our clubroom is filled with comfortable couches and a fridge stocked with cheap soft drink and chocolate. It is a great place to hang out during those long breaks... and occasional skipped lectures (Please don't skip lectures!!). Members also often run screenings in the clubroom during the week.

LIBRARY

First and foremost, UniSFA is actually a library with books in it (this may surprise some people, including existing members). We have an extensive range of science fiction (obviously) and fantasy books that we are continually adding too. You can even borrow these out if you so wish, just ask a committee member or member of the CCC to help you!

BASIC RULES

Chip Tax – If you bring wedges or chips into the clubroom the members in the room may request one from you, although they have to claim it themselves.

Seating – Only those on committee business or those disposing of rubbish may retain their seat when they are not in it.

Rubbish – Throwing or leaving rubbish within the clubroom is not tolerated and will result in a temporary ban.

EVENTS

Fresher Welcome

Fresher welcome is the first official UniSFA event where you will get to meet old and new members of the club as well as your fellow freshers. It is a great chance to get to know everyone in the clubroom a little bit better. There will probably also be some sort of food provided and who doesn't love food?!

Annual General Meeting (Friday, 6 February)

This is where we hold elections for committee members, including the president, vice president, treasurer, sexytary, librarian, OCMs and the Fresher rep. Every official member of the club is welcome to this event and is welcome to vote on who will be leading the club in the year ahead!

Easter Picnic (Weekend after Easter)

Picnic and easter egg hunt, because who doesn't like nature and chocolate. A nice change of scenery from the clubroom is always good!

UniSFA/ UCC/ Unigames Quiz Night (usually in May)

A joint event run by the three named clubs with prizes generously donated by our lovely sponsors. This event is held in the UWA tavern in first semester and is therefore only for members who will be 18+ by this time of the year.

Cameron Hall Charity Vigil (study break Semester 2)

The Cameron hall clubs come together to support a selected charity by staying awake in Cameron hall overnight! Each of the Different clubs hold different events in their club rooms, such as screenings, N64 competitions, a LAN and tabletop gaming. Sleeping is banned on campus though, so you do actually have to stay awake for this event.

Hobbit's Picnic (a weekend near the 22nd September)

Similar to the Easter picnic event except instead of an Easter egg hunt, there is a hairy feet competition. So actually it's quite different, but we still go outside. The picnic is a celebration of Bilbo & Frodo Baggins' Birthdays and is held around the 22nd of September.

Book Club

We have a book club! It doesn't meet very often and I'm not entirely sure they discuss books, but we still have one.

Relay for Life

UniSFA participated in Relay for Life for the first time ever in 2014, and it was an amazingly fun time! Clearly, as the most sports club on campus, it was only natural the UniSFA were the best and coolest people on the track. We have immortalised the relay baton in the clubroom in trophy form.

Screenings


Screenings are run on most days of semester, after around 6pm and are held by members of both committee and CCC (as they can hold the room open). What is screened changes quite a bit and there is always a good variety. Look to the whiteboard within the clubroom to see what is being screened when.

Committee Meetings

Normally at a set time weekly, these are held so that the club can continue to run smoothly and so committee members can feel like they are doing stuff. The room is not usually closed during these meetings but it is important to be quiet, as they are an important part of running the club and the sooner they are over the quicker you can get back to being loud.

Sponsor Crawls

These occur sporadically throughout the year, involving a group of UniSFAns trekking around the CBD, hunting for science fiction and fantasy literature, both novel and comic. We have also used this to help scour out books & GNs for the club's library as well as our own individual collections.

Jono Astbury – Keeper of memes and jock enthusiast. Will kick your ass at Smash Bros.


IPP - Immediate Past President.

Sheldon Chambers – Most flexible 2014. Able to put foot directly in mouth.


Simon Shook – Has a grinder just in case he runs out coffee.
