 - Timeframe-wise, it's looking like it'll be \$110>\$120
- If we can sell tickets tomorrow, we might be able to do \$100>\$110, because we can cut off early bird tickets 3 weeks before the event
- Motion for \$100 ticket becoming \$110 on the 9th

 - Children's book
 - 4th book but standalone
 - ~20 US

 - Good reviews

 - Very damaged – pages falling out but no missing pages
 - Library reject (ay)
 - Well liked, minor classic
 - Motion to remove: 1 in favour, 7 against
- George C Foster – The Change/2001 AD
 - Part of a series?
 - Old
 - Well respected author
 - Worth a great deal ~70 and not available
 - Motion to remove: 1 in favour, 7 against
- Julia Grey – the Red Glacier
 - No books 1, 2, 3 in series (guardian cycle)
 - Decent reviews
 - Motion to remove: 3 in favour, 6 against
- Julia Grey – Fire Music
 - Less well liked
 - Well read but not especially enjoyed

- Second book in two book series
 - Motion to remove: Unanimous
- 1990 (based on TV show by Ed Woodwood) by Wilfred Greatorex
 - Predicted Brexit lmao
 - Like 1984 but a little more
 - Fairly well regarded if not super widely read
 - Out of print
 - Motion to remove: 1 in favour, 8 against
- Colonisation: Aftershocks by Harry Turtledove
 - We have book 1
 - Well liked and very well read
 - We have a little Harry Turtledove, we should consider completing it
 - Motion to remove: 3 in favour, 6 against
- Ben Bova's Voyagers III, Star Watchman, The Multiple Man
 - Voyagers and SW are parts of series
 - SW isn't very well-read
 - [[Harry has to leave because the Bova Deez Nuts jokes are getting to him]]
 - Motion to put Duelling Machine up for removal with Star Watchman because they are part of the same series: 7 in favour, 2 against
 - No one appears to care about either of them
 - The Multiple Man is about someone stealing the body of the president
 - Motion to remove: 8 in favour, 1 against
 - Big motion for all the books: 8 in favour, 1 against
