 - Taylor is confident she can handle this
 - Gavin has been on organising teams for LARPs before
- Most of the feedback constantly was 'stressful but on track' and only recently did that change
 - Which is why we didn't sub in more experienced people
- Simon would like a full report from Kurt on where LARP is
 - By next meeting, Simon would to decide whether to continue running SLARP, to descale it, or to cancel it altogether
- Anything we buy for the LARP, should be something we can keep and store
- Kurt and Taylor have about 40-50% of the LARP quests written

- Writers can volunteer to contribute should they wish to
- Weapons have been reduced to allow us better room to provide useable equipment
 - People can still bring their own weapons should they wish to
- Can also release an info pack detailing the kinds of nerf guns people are allowed to bring and how people may go about acquiring them
- Max person cap on 30, with the potential to extend to 40 if there's enough interest
- People can't sign up to be NPCs this year
