 - A lot to organise (in 2018) there were organisation messups
 - BAD TIME- subcommittee stepped down
 - Kurt saved larp
- Hot summary of winter larp: [tennis] tournament of fights
- Interest gauged last year- people were interested
- Feast: licenced event at Tav: unprofitable for just in tav
- Unlike quiz night we could do tav in one location inside (eg. only outside/upstairs etc)
- Can't be on Sat: tav not open (pricing increases)
- Winter larp: people not keen @current state, general consensus: not as engaging in current state
- We don't want just a fighting thing
- IDEA: small scale medieval fest: fabsoc colab and medieval club Simple how to make things, do craft, making characters, making armour, cross stitching
- Ideas proposed are hard: not a lot of people experienced in running large events
- Can we do medieval club instead of summer larp- summer>winter but organisational challenges
- Not picking up too many large events
- Winter larp: CANCELED

 - Seems kinda fucky given the very weird setup. 3 different locations that aren't clear what's going on.

- We need a larger draw for camp: large event that people are interested in- we need more appealing activities and better advertising
- If we do a camp: we need to seriously redesign- more budget for more return

 - Secure tv more

 - Short term solution for tv: buy a cabinet

- Qs: how to make space and support new TV? We have purchased the toddler-proof tv strap to help so can't be pulled forwards
- We need to get a surge protector (a type of plug board that will protect the TV from damage if there are significant fluctuations in power from the wall, eg the way the freezer broke)
- Need a cabinet for it to sit on! Longer term, I'd like to also make a drawer/door on it lockable as well
- Could buy a new one or potentially reuse current one of the stand the old TV is attached to be that can be screwed into the cabinet

- <u>Green couch</u>: large and relatively comfy, not very nice looking, hygiene? Perhaps need couch covers
- <u>Blue couches</u>: ergonomic, wide/spacious, hygiene?
- Beige modular couches: fit room very well and allow good seating, however dubious comfort quite old and sinks in most places, unknown history and hygiene are modular so allows book access
