### 2. Events

- a. SwanCon [AN]
  - i. Basic report: in total we sold \$141 of books, expenses: \$72, profit: \$69.10
    - 1. In 2018 we made 200ish dollars, not very well attended con, we met old guard, a lot of people made comments that they already had the book that we sold/had already read etc., lack of sales: people already had books and didn't want to buy them, we didn't pay for stall last year, find different way to dispose of leftover books
    - 2. Unrelated concept: advertise our club by selling them in the ref, we would not want to compete
    - 3. Next year: look into getting eftpos machine, selling other things eg. bakesale, ask for donations
    - 4. Nadia: swancon didn't do as well as we expected

  - i. 3 ppl came down from UniSFA, we got a book donated to us signed to the club,

- d. Bookshop Sponsor Crawl [AN]
  - i. Happening on Sat, sponsor (quality comics confirm), Stefen (confirm)
  - ii. Books ordered in advance for bookshop crawl, umbrella academy from comic zone coming in soon

- f. "Easter picnic" Sundowner [WC]
  - i. Checklist: booking of venue-Gazebo not listed on venue form- person who is in change back on Friday, Gazebo not officially "booked" we would like to book it though
  - ii. Alcohol is happening, how does it work if we haven't booked the space? We may need occasional liquor licence, Will is fine to go thru legislation
  - iii. Budget: current plan: BYO alcohol, don't bring spirits, are we doing mocktails? Yes and let attendees add own drinks however, most likely not a good idea, budget concerns: we are already making a significant loss on the event, having a punch w/out charging may increase that loss
  - iv. We could sell soft-drink cans from the fridge
  - v. Gold coin entry to recover some cost
  - vi. Discussion shelved: alcohol/mocktails/This can be discussed on discord
  - vii. Please include Neville re:budget discussion
  - viii. Budget needs to be redone: Neville happy to help redo
  - ix. Easter chocolates unclear @whether they are bought--Snack/drink/decorations
- g. Quiz Night [GH, FH]
  - i. Posters: Friday mid-day signing etc
  - ii. Prizes: ongoing, we have two high value prizes so far
  - iii. Ticket sales so far: no ticket sales from UniSFA
  - iv. Promoting table formation: google forms (similar to Fresher tables)

  - ii. Venue: Ern Halliday (Spinnaca but not really free unless we have camp in January) and Woodman point not desirable (eliminated), Lesch removed
    - 1. January not a desirable time, not good for engagement
    - 2. Last year's camp not a good venue

Screenings- evening binges, don't want screenings running throughout all camp, one or two in the evenings- late night screenings people choose their own (noise controlled and fine with venue), Binge watch series as group, jump scare evening (we play spooky video games), Wallace and Gromit cheese night
