 - 3. Motion to amend budget for easter picnic chocolate from \$30 to \$35.05

- ii. Continuing organisation
- iii. Will: Sundowner
 - 1. Cannot hire at gazebo nor drink at it legally
 - 2. Every event held there was either illegal initially or became illegal
 - 3. Generally other clubs got around it by not mentioning it in advertising or using loopholes (e.g. hosting official event for two hours and then everyone breaks out the booze after the event has officially ended so its on the person and not the club)
 - 4. My recommendation is that we do not do this as its kinda shady and outright illegal.
 - Other venues include booking a space around matilda bay and getting licensing for that (kinda shitty in that we can't do decorations well at all and that it might rain. Don't want everybody huddled under one marquis).
 - 6. I think we should go back to a non-alcoholic event given the lack of an appropriate venue that suits the scale of the event. I'd generally say that it wouldn't be worth doing given that it'd be a similar turnout to the easter picnic (not very good), but we have the chocolate. Perhaps the mocktails idea is an option we should pursue"
- iv. Venue discussion: Not King's Park, Ref courtyard (would rather not, but if we have hired it we can eject people who aren't invited), CCZ (desirable), Matilda bay with No Alcohol and No fencing
 - Equipment: we need mosquito repellent, Papasergio: no moon, Fairy lights- UniSFA has some in cupboard, halloween stuff we could use to decorate), posters, If people have fun sci-fi decorations let us know?

 - i. Debrief from meeting
 - ii. Things were postponed bc members couldn't make it
- h. Camp [WC]
 - i. Venue: Manjedal (good), Mornington, Lesch (no), Ern Halliday (booked out)
 - ii. Itinerary ideas: a lot of people have requested Skyrim, Life is strange 2 and other video games etc, A good itinerary

- iii. Draws for camp: Good venue, good itinerary- more time for people to sit and chat, friends and supporting club, low cost, more social bonding events may increase attendance, panto showtimes, accessible and transport, encourage old guard attendance
- iv. We need to decide: Length, What to book, where to book
- v. Time: 3 nights- more time for activity and bonding. Some people can come for some days and not all- part day tickets?
- vi. It's fun if camp has a theme! Replaces houses theme
- vii. How Long: opinions- Merlin, Georgia, Neville- 3 days to bond with friends, a good chunk of time, precedent for 3 days (expected), partial tickets- will be more accessible (2 instead of 3 nights), making camp, Sergio would prefer 2, Nadia: 3 nights= two full days, for 2 nights proportionally= more time spent packing up
- viii. Confirm: Man
- ix. 20 to feed ppl across 3 nights
 - 1. If we have 20 ppl would be 33 per night plus 30 to feed
 - 2. More people goes down to 22 per person per night
 - 3. A few of the activities will cost money (potentially adds tickets)
 - 4. We should have \$115 tickets to cover cost: This would still be a loss
 - 5. If we can get 25 ppl would be 20 profit per person not regarding events (which would incur a cost)
 - 6. A two night camp would reduces our losses but we only get one day
 - Lotterywest grants: Nadia look into further and apply for some (~couches~)
 - 8. We need to get good advertising, good activities (resources for those)
- x. We would like reach 30 people attending camp!
- xi. UniSFA profit from UniSFA goes to events
- xii. Manjedal we are leaning towards
- xiii. Guild is less financial sustenance for club, we want to be more independent
- xiv. All of our events make a profit and go towards library and clubroom maintenance, members do engage with netflix which is part of library
- xv. Our events should be fun and accessible and should not be planned to make a loss
- xvi. We should not rely on other profit due to reduced guild spending

 - 1. Generally we shouldn't shy away from screening anime even though it's UWAnime's thing but anime can be sci-fi fantasy so why not

 - A suggestion that came from Annique's presidential term: have a
 regular hour during the week, either once a week or once a day, that
 is always set aside for quiet reading. It would be a good time for
 members to read graphic novels in particular. It would require some
 effort on committee and ccc part to have regularly.
