 - not comparing books with other books "ie we should keep this bc we have this other thing" we don't want to do this- consider books in isolation
 - d. Using a book as a comparison to support argument rather than it being basis of argument
- 1. Alex Rider: is an action thriller, book 2, is also a graphic novel does not scifi fantasy
 - Motion to propose removal- unan (7 unan)
- 2. "Savage dragon:terminated"- vol 8 of savage dragon series (we don't have others)- it's a continuous storyline
 - General comic books can be read non-chronologically- this possibly might be the same (based on arcs)
 - o superhero (fantasy) genre
 - Not popular? Reason to remove? (precedent for removal is not having volumes previously)
 - One of the original series "image comics" (historical significance-ish)
 - Also: the merits of the individual comic/volume should be most considered (possibly)
 - Also it was behind the couch Imao
 - Motion to propose to remove
 - All in favour 1 in favor 6 against
 - Motion fails
- 3. The Garden of Earthly Delights- non fiction, art history book discussing an art piece, religious
 - Motion to propose for removal
 - o Passes (7) unan
- 4. Rainbow 6
 - Can put up books for multiple removals (precedent)
 - We've discussed this before (See 2/4/19)
 - Rainbow 6 is the second book in the series
 - Elements of spec fic, good intro to Tom Clancy's other series
 - Weaponizing science, weaponizing bacteria/viruses- primer thriller rather than sci-fi
 - o Book is read as thriller
 - Near future sci-fi- Does it world build- not necessarily needed because most people know

- o Relevant to the times (Rainbow 6 franchise now popular)- its popular
 - If someone picks it up that's better than what other books in this room have had
- On Wiki it's referred to as "techno-thriller" (wack)
- 3 in favor, 4 against, motion fails, Katherine is sad pt 2
- 5. The Encyclopedia of Witchcraft and magic
 - Non fiction- research into existing religions and spiritualities
 - Also a bit damaged
 - Not relevant ie non fiction textbook
 - Book about religion (similarly to art book)
 - Isn't a book about sci-fi or fantasy
 - Talks about the folklore of magic around the world
 - Magic loosely defined as interacting with non-scientific/magical/unseen/unconfirmed etc
 - A lot of it is historical witchcraft tho- helping to describe things that inform fantasy/witches
 - Seems to read as author practices "magic" rather than non academic reflection on magical cultures (seems a bit off)
 - Neville's Take: having this book in the library, which is a library of science-fiction and fantasy, implies religious beliefs as "magic/fantasy" - context of where it stands= not comfortable)
 - Encyclopedia def: language used in terms of defining/history etc
 - In reading fantasy books that refer to witchcraft could be a useful reference
 - Having knowledge of things relating to religion and how they engage with "magical traditions" eg how engaging in witchcraft
 - Establishing as "reference" section- use materials relating to sci fi fantasy
 - Academic ref would be useful
 - o It's a mistake to get rid of things that our members use
 - The non-fiction section= informal reference
 - o Encyclopedia of nonfiction and fiction
 - Katherine and Annique volunteer to make reference section
 - New book theme? Things that have shaped the way we represent sci-fi fantasy- with CWAP
 - Culture of religious things being iffy: does it promote religious ideas or mock religion? We don't want these things.
 - Motion to propose to remove encyclopedia of witchcraft and magic: 1 in favor: 6, motion fails
